## A Warning

Do not minimize sin
Be careful not to adjust our convictions in order to accommodate sin.
First we ignore or forget basic truth about sin
We begin to listen to lies
We adjust our conviction to accommodate sin

We start to adjust our convictions, our doctrine, to make room for our morality.

Sin, at first, is overlooked and then it's tolerated and then it's indulged. Then it is positively affirmed, not as sin any longer but as a good thing until the real sinner here is the apostle Paul.
