In popular culture, men are often celebrated because how they stand against opposition. Unfortunately, women are celebrated oftentimes through their objectification. As the month of May approaches, we should study how the Bible honors women.

The recounting of Israel's deliverance from slavery makes of Exodus one of the most significant Old Testament books. **Have you ever noticed that almost the whole first section of Exodus honors certain women primarily for faith in God that caused them to take risks?**

In Exodus 1:15 Shiphrah and Puah are honored for fearing God and not Pharaoh. *"But the midwives feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the male children live."* (EXODUS 1:17) Because they defied the Pharaoh who wanted them

to murder, the Bible says: *"And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families."* (EXODUS 1:21) For all of history, the world will know the names of these two God-fearing women.

Another result of their obedience to the Lord is found in chapter 2 verse 2. I am talking about the birth of Moses. *"The woman conceived and bore a son, and when she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him three months."* (EXODUS 2:2) Of course you know the story of how she made a basket of bulrushes and put little Moses where Pharaoh's daughter would find him.


Here we find that not only Moses' mother, but also his sister exercised faith in God. For when the daughter of Pharaoh found him, his sister offered to find a nurse. *"Then his sister said to Pharaoh's*

*daughter, 'Shall I go and call you a nurse from the Hebrew women to nurse the child for you?' And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, 'Go.' So the girl went and called the child's mother."* (EXODUS 2:7-8)

Moses' life was saved by women who loved and feared the Lord. The Bible shows who to celebrate and honor by honoring women, such as; Ruth, Esther, Mary, Dorcas, Elizabeth, Lydia and many others. This next month let us also celebrate the God-honoring women in our lives..

# A TIMELESS STORY OF RELENTLESS LOVE

On Good Friday, April 2nd, PBC was honored to provide a livestreamed presentation of *Sight & Sounds* stage production, "*Jesus*". Billed as "*A Timeless Story of Relentless Love*", this masterful production traces the life of Jesus through the gospels and the OT prophecies that pointed to Him as the long-awaited Messiah. Though any portrayal of the King of Kings is going to fall short, especially limited by time and technology, they presented a wonderful picture of Jesus.

Roughly 125 people came to experience this livestream event on our two large screens. During the 20 minute intermission, there was time for fellowship, while enjoying individually wrapped, pre-packaged snacks and drinks in the Gym Alcove.

Very little was lost in the televised event compared to viewing in a live theater setting. An exceptional job was done capturing the angles that showed the extensive action occurring across a 300 foot stage.

The settings of this action-packed musical stage adventure took us from the bustling streets of Jerusalem to the raging Sea of Galilee. Introduced us to Biblical characters

such as Peter, John and the other apostles, as well as Nicodemus, Mary Magdalene, and a multitude of others as they journeyed alongside Jesus. We watched them as they experienced the miracles and heard the parables, and how their lives were changed in the process.

**Highlights** from the production included the cleansing of the Temple, the "*slow-motion*" sequence of Jesus telling the people the parable of the Prodigal Son while it was also being re-enacted in real time, and of course the Resurrection scene. It is always helpful to see the Biblical characters portrayed so that we remember they were real people, with real struggles. **Some favorites:** Mary Magdalene's recollecting about where she had been, who she had been and what Jesus had done for her. Jesus' mother Mary's heart-wrenching reminiscence about Jesus as an infant after his crucifixion. Nicodemus' coming to grips with and accepting Jesus as Messiah as He fulfilled one prophecy after another.

One individual noted that this showing on Good Friday helped *re-set their focus* so that it was properly shifted to Jesus and the Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

## Celebrate Mom . . .

*Mother's Day is Sunday, May 9th!*

The United States celebration of Mother's Day dates back to the 19th century. Julia Ward Howe was the first person to suggest the observance of a Mother's Day in 1872. Howe wrote the "Mother's Day Proclamation" in 1870 as a call for mothers to promote world peace. After three years, she campaigned for the observance of Mother's Peace Day.

In 1887, Mary Towles Sasseen, a Kentucky school teacher, began conducting Mother's Day celebrations and in 1904, Frank E. Hering of South Bend, Indiana began a campaign for the observance of Mother's

Day. However, it wasn't until Anna Jarvis, of West Virginia, began a nationwide campaign for its observance that the idea took root.

Woodrow Wilson signed a joint resolution of Congress recommending the observance of Mother's Day by executive branches of the government on May 9, 1914. The following year, Mother's Day was designated an annual national observance to honor one's own mother, as well as motherhood, maternal bonds, and the influence of mothers in society.










## Audio Visual Lighting Ministry
